

Power Rates - N. Wasco County

Electrical power is provided in the Port of The Dalles District primarily by Northern Wasco County PUD, www.nwasco.com or 541.296.2226.

Demand Rate - Schedule 250:

- Electric service to all three-phase and all single-phase customers with total demand of over 50 kW in any one of the past 11 months.
- Alternating current, sixty hertz, 120/240, 120/208, 277/480 or 480 volts nominal, single or three-phase.
- Monthly rate: \$94 per month facilities charge; plus \$6.30 per kW demand charge; plus 3.72 cents per kWh energy charge.

Primary Service - Schedule 300:

- Electric service to three-phase customers taking delivery at primary voltage.
- Alternating current, sixty hertz, 2400, 12470/7200, and 69000 volts.
- Monthly rate: \$530 per metering point; plus \$5.55 per kW demand charge, plus 3.61 cents per kWh energy charge.

Large load customers:

- Prospective customers with peak loads expected to exceed 1 megawatt may request a facility site evaluation to explore the feasibility of taking service at a facility within the PUD's service area.
- Rates are negotiated based on facilities needed to provide service, the PUD's embedded costs of service and wholesale power rates.
- Customers may request environmental attributes and other rate features that meet their specific business objectives.

*Billing demand is the average kilowatts delivered during the 30-minute period in which the use of energy is greatest during the month for which the determination is made.
